4.1 Transporting the Game

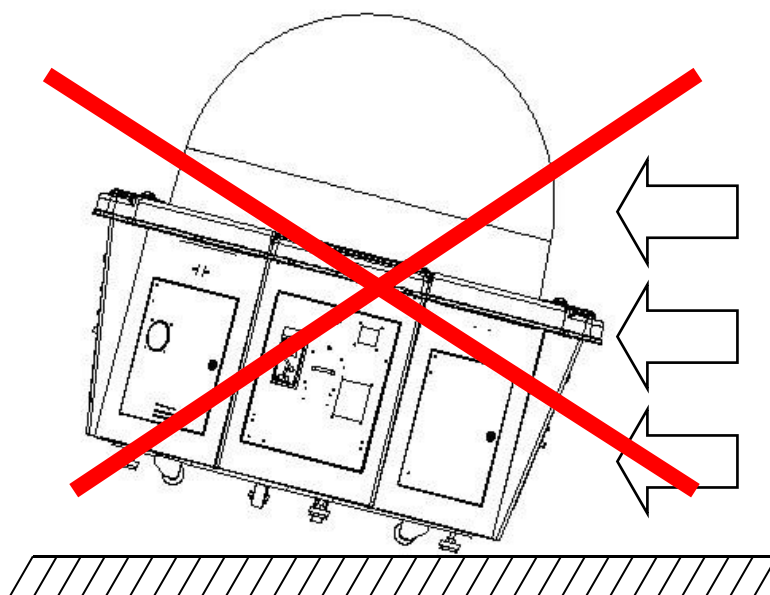
If you need to move the game, adjust the levelers back to an “up” position.



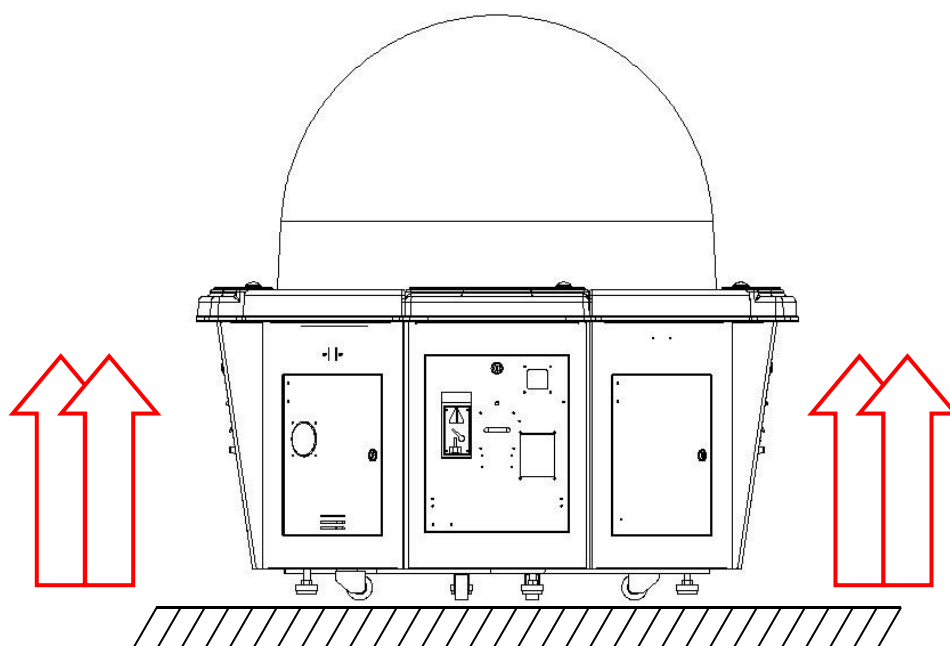

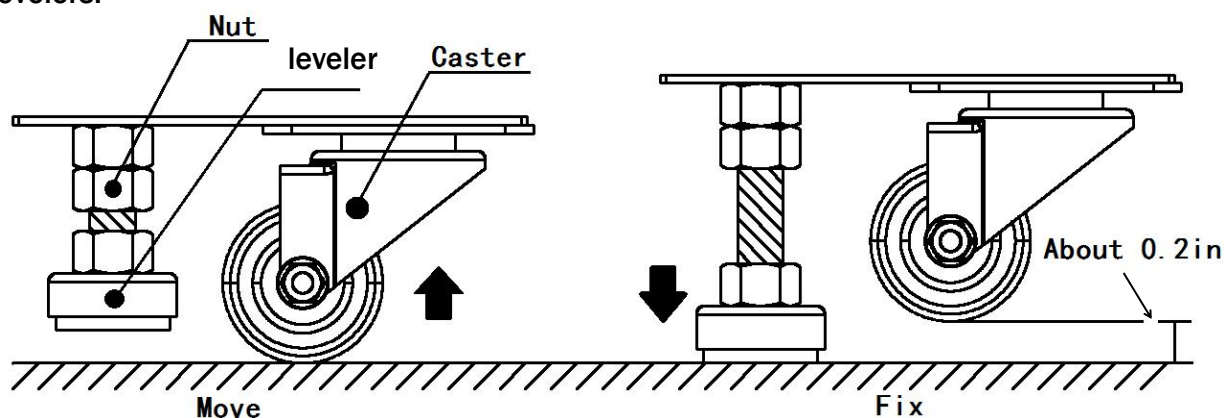

4.2 Level Adjustment

Install this game on a flat surface. If the game is installed on an unsuitable floor, it could cause game malfunction.

To secure the game, loosen the nut, utilize wrench to adjust the leveler down until it touches the floor, lifting the casters off the ground by 0.2 in. Repeat the same for all levelers.

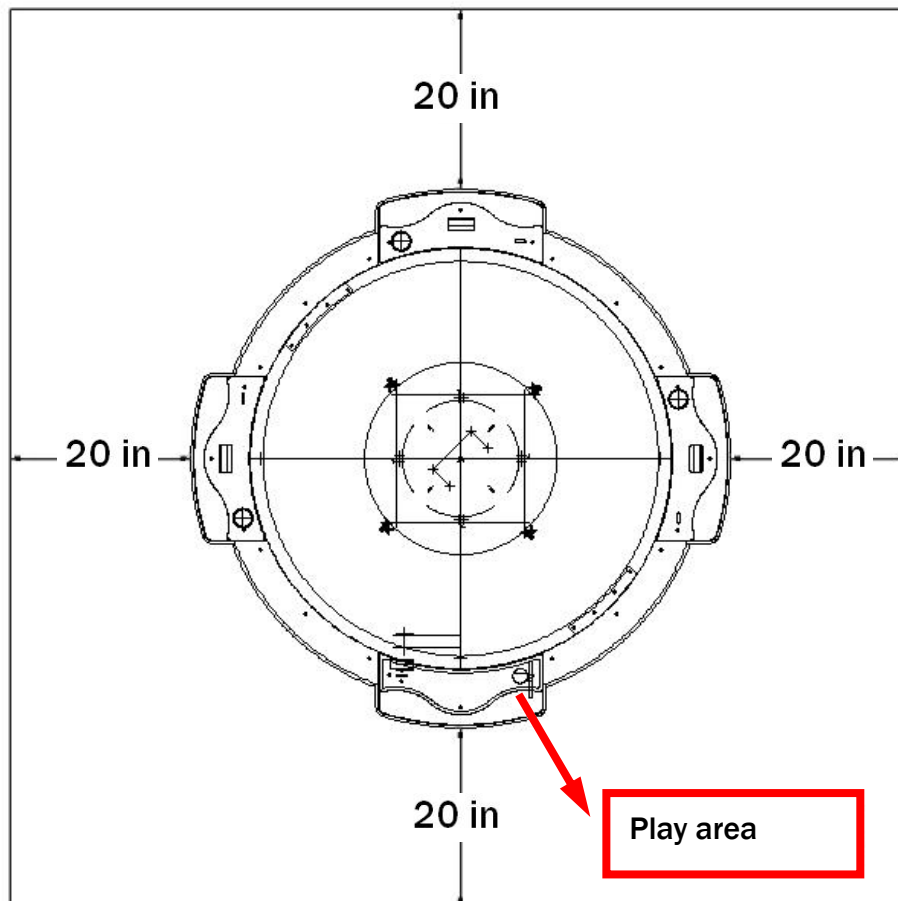

4.4 Instruction of Resetting The Machine to Normal Mode

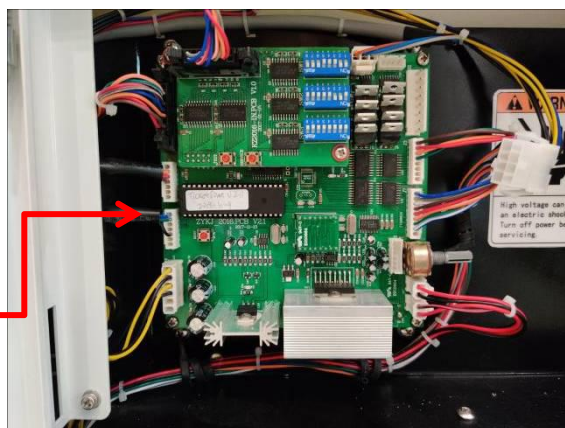
In order to avoid damage during transportation, the machine is preset to Transportation mode, in which all the scoops are lowered and fixed.

Warning: The machine needs to be reset to Normal mode upon unpacking. Please follow the steps.

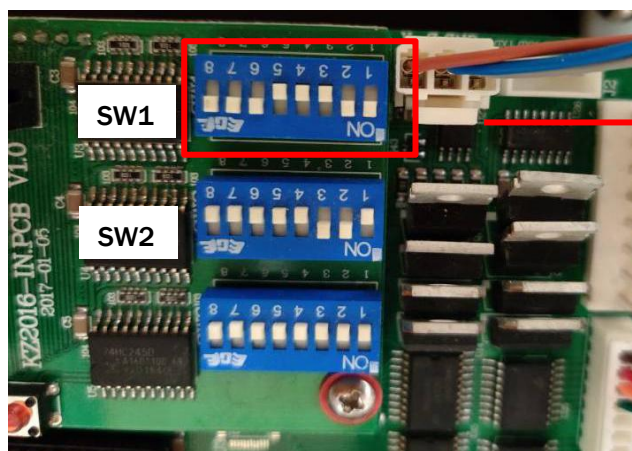

4.5 Card Reader Installation

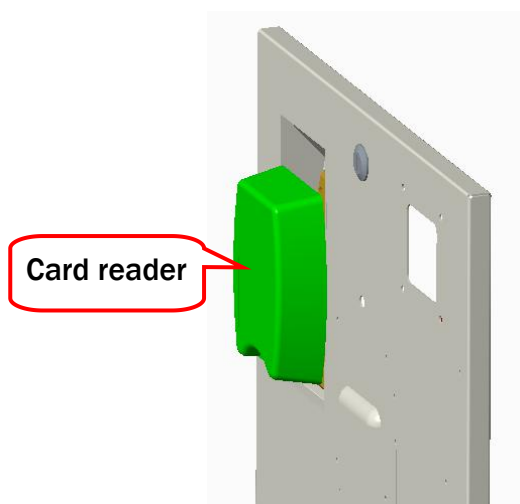
Step 1 Locate the Coin door. Open the coin door. Utilize Allen wrench(2.5mm) to loosen 4 screws to remove Card reader plate.



Step 2 Utilize knife or scissors to cut properly decal position for Card reader. Utilize Spanner to loosen 2 nuts indicated by circles. Place Card reader receiver on it and install it by 2 nuts.



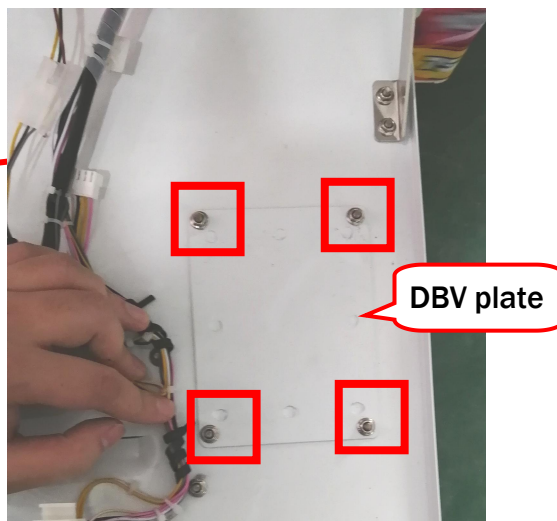
Step 3 Place Card reader on it. Utilize Allen wrench(2.5mm) to tighten 4 screws to Card reader. Connect Card reader connector.



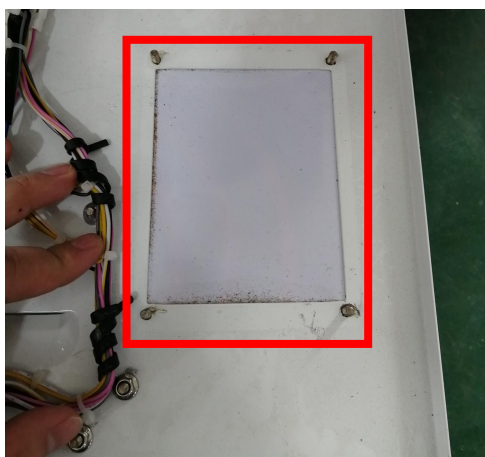

Step 4 Place Diamond marquee to the Cabinet. Insert the Marquee connector into the cabinet hole; Utilize screws to secure the Marquee.

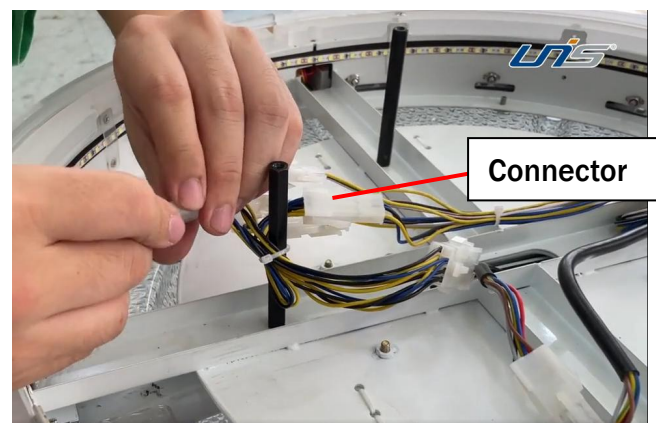

7.1 Common Problem

Please confirm whether every connector connected tightly.

Symptom	Possible Cause	Recommended action

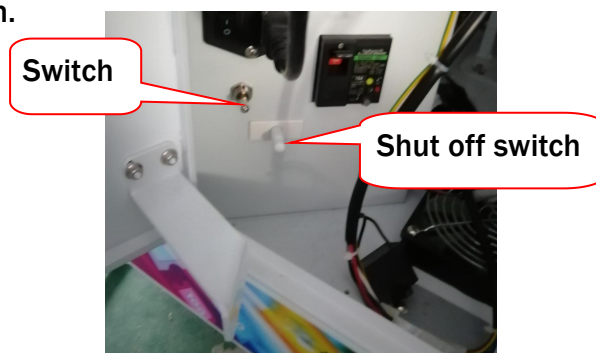

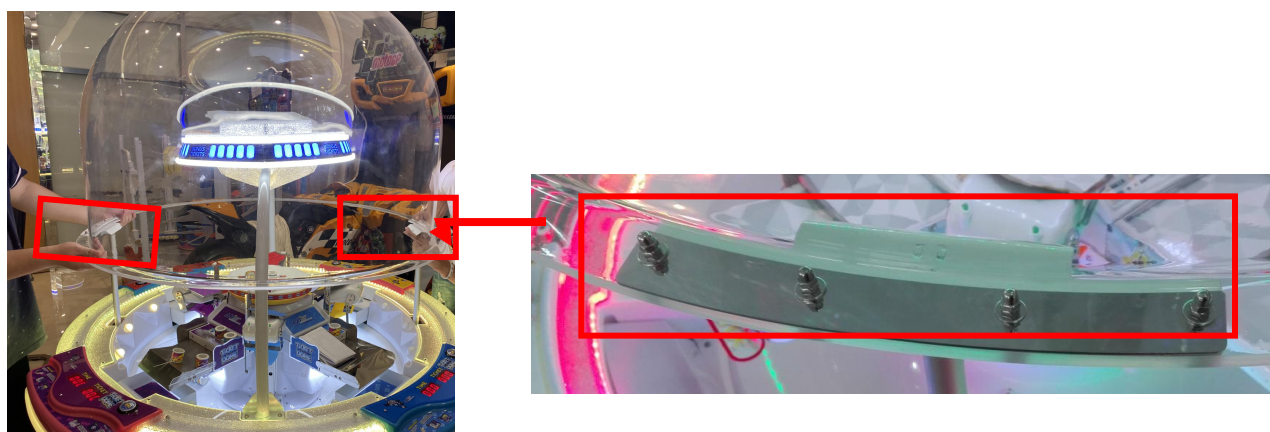
How to Remove The Dome Cover Before Maintenance

Step 1 Power on the machine. Open the service door between Purple player and Blue player. Turn the Switch to UP side to raise the dome up.

Note: If the machine is not power on successfully. Pull the Shut off switch out and power on the machine again.



Step 2 Utilize Spanner(5.5/7) to remove 8 nuts from the metal plate and take the dome out.



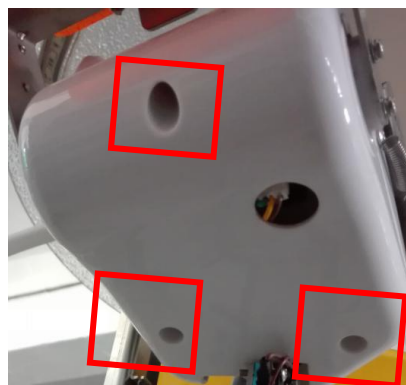
