Inspect Immediately after Transporting the Product

After receiving the shipment, inspect the product thoroughly to ensure that it has been shipped with care. Before turning the power on, please check the following:

- Check the cabinet for damage or shifting that may have occurred during shipping. Are there any dented portions or defects (cuts, etc.) on the external surfaces of the cabinet?
- Are all the legs and adjusters/levelers/feet intact (often shipped inside the table with other accessories)?
- Do the power supply voltage and frequency requirements meet with those of the location (110V/220V)?
- Are all wires linked correctly and securely connected to each other? If coupled
 in an incorrect manner, the connection will not be made accurately and it could
 cause not only irreparable damage to the machine, but also is a potential fire
 hazard. Do Not Insert Connectors Forcibly.
- Check that all the cables, including power cables, are undamaged. Do power cables or other wires have any splices, cuts, or dents?

Important Notes

- 1. Read this Instruction Manual carefully before assembling or playing.

- Two strong adults are recommended to assemble the product.
- 4. Inspect and ensure all parts are securely attached before rotating the table.
- 5. Please Note: Children and pets should be kept away from assembly and game pieces; this table contains small parts and balls that could be a potential choking hazard.
- 6. Very Important: Only 1 ball may be inside the machine at a time. Please check to see if your machine was shipped with a ball inside the machine before inserting another ball. The machine will not function if more than one ball is inside the mechanism.




Assembly – Step (2) (Prepare the Table)

Carefully open the packaging carton.
 Open table at the hinges (like a chest) and remove all accessories from inside.

In order to assemble the legs, it is easiest to disassemble the table so only the bottom half the table needs to be rotated.

*Please note: The interior mechanisms of your model table may vary in slightly appearance from the instruction photos.



2. Disassemble all the air connectors from all wires that connect the upper and lower halves of the table.






3. Adult #2 should support the top half of the table while Adult #1 removes any additional connections.

 Locate the bolts of the pneumatic lidcloser arm. The bolts are found on the top part of the table, near the track of the arm.







Assembly – Step (2) (Prepare the Table)

- 5. Adult #2 should continue to hold the top half of table while Adult #1 removes the bolts from the arm (pneumatic lid-closer arm) at the top of the table. Only remove the bolts from the **TOP HALF** of table.
- ** Be sure to have a safe place to store all the screws and bolts for reassembly.



6. Next, Adult #1 should remove the bolts on the rightmost hinge to separate the top half of the table.

The left and center hinges are detachable, you do not need to remove the screws, just slide apart to detach them.



The detachable ones unhinge like this:



7. Ensure that all bolts, hinges, and air connectors that connect both halves of the table are disconnected. Then, lift the top half of the table and separate it from the bottom.



8. Carefully set the top half of the table on a piece of cardboard out of the way (glass down). You will reattach the top half after attaching the legs to the bottom half.





Assembly – Step ② (Prepare the Table)

9. Assemble all 4 legs by attaching each foot. Screw 1 foot into the bottom of each leg.



10. Using both adults, turn the bottom of the table onto its side and affix the legs into the table using the (included) carriage bolts.

Be sure to place a washer between the bolt head and the cabinet.



11. After ensuring all of the legs are tightly secured, both adults should carefully lift and rotate the table to a standing position.




12. Next, both adults should lift the top half of table up and combine it with the bottom half of table.





Assembly − **Step ②** (**Prepare the Table**)

13. While Adult #2 holds the top half of the table, Adult #1 should reaffix the 2 detachable hinges together to reconnect the table.




14. Finally, reaffix the RIGHTMOST hinge.



15. Reattach the pneumatic arm at the top of the table.

Reconnect all the air connectors that link the top and bottom of the unit.



16. If your table arrived partially assembled, you're ready to skip to Assembly Step 4.

If you need to assemble the foosball players and rods, continue following these assembly instructions.





Assembly – Step 3 (Assemble the Rods & Players)

If your World Tour Foosball table did not come partially assembled with the foosball players and rods assembled in the table, please follow these additional instructions:

1. On the **RIGHT SIDE OF THE TABLE**, remove the bolts from the upper side (only from the RIGHT side).




2. On the **RIGHT SIDE OF THE TABLE**, remove the end cap, corner pieces, and metal parts.




3. Carefully remove the tempered glass from the **RIGHT SIDE** of the table by sliding it toward you.



4. Reinstall the factory-removed black bearings on all the rod holes using a nut driver and hardware provided.



5. Begin to assemble the rods and the players. Sort the foosball player rods by length:






Assembly – Step (2) (Assemble the Rods & Players)


Use this page as a guide for assembling the rods and foosball players.

Do not begin assembly until you have read ALL ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS!





Use the included lubricating oil to aid in rod and player assembly.




IMPORTANT NOTE We recommend assembling all the pieces on the playfield first (before tightly securing the players to the rods) to make sure all the players are in the right position. Continue to STEP 3 to tightly secure the players once you're positive everything is placed according to the aerial view.

- 1. Begin assembling the rods from the left side of the table. Starting with the 1-player rod (goalie rod/rod style #2/3-holed rod), slide the rod into the table.
- 2. Next slide on a rubber stopper (F), a plastic rod spacer (E), a metal place holderif goalie rod (C)* and the foosball player/s (B).
- 3. The players will line up with small holes in the rod. Make sure the player is facing in the proper direction.
- 4. Once all the pieces have been placed on the rod, secure them tightly in Assembly Step 3.

^{*}Note: The gray metal place holders are only used for the two goalie bars.



This is a view from the top of what the rods, spacers, and foosball players should look like once assembled.




Assembly – Step **G** (Secure the Players to the Rods)


Once all of the players and rods have been assembled, secure each player to the rod using a <u>rubber mallet</u>, <u>two blocks of wood</u>, <u>one roll pin for each player</u>, and the <u>roll pin aid</u> provided.




To keep the rod from spinning, stabilize the bar using the 2 wooden blocks provided, shown here in blue. Turn the player facedown and adjust the player so that the hole on the player matches the rod hole.





- Adjust the player so that the hole in the pole lines up with the hole in the player. Insert the roll pin aid (stabilizer) into the hole from below. This will stabilize the player while you insert the roll pin from the top.
- Insert the roll pin into the top of the player and gently knock the roll pin through the player and rod with a small rubber mallet.





- Gently hammer the roll pin through the top of the player through the rod with a small rubber mallet. Remove the roll pin stabilizer from the bottom when it has been pushed more than half out.
- Once you have removed the roll pin stabilizer, use it to tap the roll pin (from the top) until the roll pin is completely flush with the player.








Assembly – Step @ (Secure the Players to the Rods)

After Assembling the Players

- 1. After putting the rods inside of the table, reinstall the tempered glass carefully and retighten all the bolts. Then, attach the 4 cup holders with hex bolts to each end (2 per short side).
- 2. Open the table and put ONE ball in the track. Also, put the PCB COVER above the PC Board.



3. Using the included allen key, secure each cup holder to the short ends of the table. There are 2 cup holders per table end (4 total).





4. Plug in the electrical cord and turn on the power (under the table on the right side) to ensure all lights, motors, and computer functions are operable.





How to Set a Constant Coin*

Continue reading for a visual diagram of these steps.

Step 1

Choose the desired coin for use and insert it in the clamp on the side of the coin comparator/coin mechanism. This coin is now considered the "constant" based on coin size, thickness, metallic properties, and coin diameter. Only these types of coins will be accepted until a new constant coin is installed.

Step 2

Adjust the coin insert size to the size of your Constant Coin (front panel back side).

Step 3

Select the correct mode: Normal Open/Normal Close

"Timer Switch" for synchronizing your system:


- 100ms (Slow Speed / Long Pause)
- 50ms (Medium Speed / Medium Pause)
- 30ms (Fast Speed / Short Pause)

Step 4


Adjust VR Sensitivity Tuning:






Test the Motor Function



- 1. If you want to test lifting the motor, press the K2 button of the tact switches several times, until 08 is shown.
- 2. Press the K1 button of the tact switches to confirm the action. Then, the motor will start to lift.
- 3. After the test, press the K1 button again to stop the lifting mechanism from lifting.

Initiate a Coin Audit

- 1. Turn the table off and press K1 on the PC Board for audit.
- 2. The screen (just above the K1~K4 buttons) will show the quantity of coins.
- 3. Press K3 and K4 to zero the counter.
- 4. Press K1 to quit the audit function.

Voltage Issues:

Voltage issues may be due to a card swipe system attached to the table which is causing the power supply to be unstable. Card swipe systems and powered accessories must be attached to their own independent power supply.

The 12V/5V power supply which is in the table can have its output adjusted by using the knob (called a "trimpot") on the front of the power supply. Check the voltage coming out of the power supply. If you are not using a card swipe system, adjust the trimpot by rotating it clockwise or counter-clockwise as necessary to increase or decrease the output

Initiate a Coin Audit:


- 1. Turn the table off and press K1 on the PC Board for audit.
- 2. The screen (just above the K1~K4 buttons) will show the quantity of coins.
- 3. Press K3 and K4 to zero the counter.
- 4. Press K1 to guit the audit function.


Error 22/23:

Begin by following all of the steps in the **Troubleshooting the Elevating Device** section of this manual. Be sure to 1) grease the actuator, 2) reset the actuator motor and 3) troubleshoot the ball sensors.

If the problems persist: there is one yellow wire near the elevating device that may not be connecting properly. Make sure the game is powered off and unplugged when adjusting wiring.

- 1. Ensure that this bundle of 4 wires are all properly connected.
- 2. Carefully press the 4 silver parts to separate the wires from the air connector; then reconnect them all.
- 3. Ensure the METAL piece of the wire is a little raised (red circle on yellow wire pictured on right)
- 4. It's possible the wires were not connecting completely. Reboot the machine.







Troubleshooting the PC Board

LED screens above the goals will show the errors codes when the table is out of order. When there is an error, press the Troubleshooting Button. Here is a list of error codes:

Error Codes

10	Coin comparator 1: coin stuck
11	Coin comparator 2: coin stuck
20	Ascent of elevating device is out of order. (see section: Troubleshoot the Elevating Device)
21	Descent of elevating device is out of order. (see section: Troubleshoot the Elevating Device)
22	The ball is not in the track. (Check the sensor nearest the ball release)
23	The ball does not score. (Check the sensor nearest the goal)
30	Safety switch is not pressed.

Troubleshooting the Elevating Device

A Quick Check


"When the actuator raises the ball at the start of the game, the arm rises above the playfield."

Try this:

The metal part of this MICRO SWITCH should be pulled down a little.

So when the ball raises, the black bar should touch the metal part of the micro switch earlier.

The white cylinder will also stop sooner and shouldn't carry the actuator arm above the playfield.





Troubleshooting the Elevating Device

1 Grease the Ball Actuator


If you are experiencing a malfunction with the elevating device, attempt to **add a dab of grease** before disassembling the ball actuator:

- 1. To prevent the mechanism from getting stuck, add some grease to the elevating device. This should help it lift more smoothly.
- 2. On the mechanism, pull the gate down and also put some grease on the elevating device; **ONLY** the area that touches the gate needs to be lubricated.
- 3. DO NOT put grease inside of the track, otherwise, the ball will become oily.

<u>CAUTION: PINCH POINT!</u> Do not put fingers near elevating device. The actuator moves fast and will not stop until it has moved completely up or completely down.







If you continue to experience malfunctions with the ball actuator / elevating device, continue troubleshooting.

2 Reset the Actuator Motor



. Loosen the 2 screws above the motor.



2. Loosen the 4 screws at the bottom of the device.





3. Press the K1 button on the PC board. At the same time, turn on the power with your other hand.




4. The screen should show 00.



5. Press the K2 button of the tact switches several times, until the screen reads 08.




6. Press the K1 button of the tact switches to confirm the action. Then, the motor will start to lift.



7. After attempting this several times, the lifting will become smoother. Then, press the K1 button of the tact switches to stop the lifting.



8. Re-tighten the 6 screws.





Troubleshooting the Elevating Device

9. **To retest the motor:** Press the K2 button of the tact switches for several times, until 08 shown on the screen. Then, press the K1 button of the tact switches to confirm the action. The motor will start to lift.

<u>CAUTION: PINCH POINT!</u> Do not put fingers near elevating device. The actuator moves fast and will not stop until it has moved completely up or completely down.

10. If the lifting remains smooth, it's fixed. Press the K1 button of the tact switches to stop the lifting. If not, please re-loosen the 6 screws and repeat the same steps.

3 Troubleshoot the Ball Sensor

Be sure to REMOVE THE BALL from inside the table first.


No ball should be on the track or inside the actuator when this test is being administered.



1. Press K1 button on the PCB. At the same time, turn on power with other hand.



2. The screen should show 00.



3. Press the K2 button of the tact switches several times, until the screen reads 03.



4. If all sensors are functioning, four zeros will appear on the prompt (0000) indicating no sensors need repair.


- Nut Driver (8mm) Included with Foosball Table
 OR Socket Wrench / Ratchet (8mm)
- Hand Drill (5mm drill bit)
- Lubricating Oil Included with Foosball Table
- A Piece of Scrap Wood

^{*}Note: Please retain the original packaging, so that it may be used for storage or transport later.




This guide instructs you on how to install metal rod protectors onto a pre-assembled foosball table.

A fully-assembled table will look like this from above:






 Standing in front of the table where the locks are located, find the <u>RIGHT SIDE OF THE TABLE</u>.
 From the right side, remove the end cap, corner pieces, and other metal parts.



2. Carefully remove the tempered glass from the **RIGHT SIDE** of the table by sliding it toward you. Temporarily store the glass in a safe place.




3. Beginning with the left side, slide the first rod slightly out so that you can install the protector to the side opposite the handle.




**Please Note: You may need to remove the foremost foosball player using the pin extractor to slide the rod out with enough room to work. For more information on how to remove a player, consult the World Tour Foosball Coin-Op Table Instruction Manual.


4. From the inner side of the table, remove the screws and black bearing from the rod hole.
Note: Do not remove all the bearings. You do not need to remove them all from both sides of the table, only the bearings that will be covered with rod protectors.






- 5. If your table came with pre-drilled holes for the rod protectors, skip to the drilling steps. If you need to drill additional holes: place a wooden panel of scrap wood on the outer side of the table. From the inner side of the table, drill out the two (2) pilot holes until they become through holes.
- 6. Temporarily affix the left and the right sides of the rod protector onto the table with two (2) of the longer bolts (4.75cm) and nuts.





7. Using the drill, make two (2) pilot/blind holes for the top and bottom bolts (pilot holes do not go all the way through the wood).

Take care to drill straight into the table, not at an angle!



8. Unbolt and remove the rod protector. Place a wooden panel of scrap wood inside the table and continue to drill the 2 blind holes until they become through holes. Using scrap wood should minimize the potential for damage to the laminate while drilling.





9. Affix the metal rod protector using four (4) bolts: 2 short (4.5cm) and 2 long (4.75 cm).



10. The nuts should be snugly tightened from the inner side of the table.



11. Tighten a second nut on top of every first nut.





12. Repeat all the steps to install the remaining seven (7) metal rod protectors. Each side of the table will have four (4) rod protectors, from left to right:




- U Long Rod
- 2 Med Rod
- 3 Short Rod




13. Insert the assembled foosball player rods into the rod protector for each rod.

Insert the foosball rod into the rod protector





*Please Note: You will need to lubricate the rod as well as the bearings to slide the rods into the protectors with ease.





15. From the right side of the table, reassemble the end cap, corner pieces, and metal parts.



16. Ensure all rods move smoothly and with ease inside the rod protectors. If the rods are sticking or do not move smoothly, apply more lubricant.



17. Plug the table back in, turn on the power, and begin playing!

After Installing the Game

- 1. Check the voltage regularly to avoid a short circuit or potential fire. Do not overload the circuit.
- 2. Keep the power cord out of areas with busy foot traffic to ensure the safety of users and the machine.
- 3. Keep children away from all power sources. Children should always be under adult supervision while using the machine. Youth under 120cm (roughly 4ft) in height should not operate this machine.
- 4. Regular maintenance should be performed on the machine to ensure that it is clean, smooth, and debris-free (see section "Care and Maintenance").
- 5. Do not use any sharp instruments on any part of the machine as it may cause irreparable damage.
- 6. Remove and replace any piece or part that becomes damaged.
- 7. Turn off the game and have it inspected by an electrician or service technician if it is operating abnormally. Contact an electrician or service technician if your product experiences power failure, liquid or objects found near/inside the electronic components, or abnormal sounds coming from the actuator (the automatic ball release).
- 8. Use the leg adjusters to level the table if necessary.
- 9. Do not use outdoors or in damp areas.
- 10. Take extra care when handling the tempered glass panel, it may break.

Care and Maintenance

- 1. Perform maintenance work in accordance with these instructions. Always be sure to turn off the power before servicing the machine.
- 2. Use a soft cloth, and product-specific polishing spray to clean the cabinet. **THE GLASS PLAYFIELD COVER SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH GLASS CLEANER ONLY.**
- 3. Dust, grime, and other debris can collect inside the body of your table over time. Vacuum out the inside cavities frequently. The easiest way to access the inside of the table is to remove the glass plate and clean the playfield and foosball players. Opening the cabinet will also give you access to excess dust that may have built up inside the goal chutes. **NEVER ATTEMPT** to clean the automatic ball release system while the game is operating.
- 4. Clean any dirt or debris from the main PC Board with a soft brush or dry cloth. NEVER USE WATER OR OTHER LIQUIDS. Always be sure to turn off or unplug the machine before opening the PC Board panel.
- 5. Household cleaner may be used to wipe down the poles, handles, and legs.
- 6. Dust the scoreboard when needed (depending on the model).
- 7. Periodically check the functionality of the coin mechanisms and empty coin boxes.
- 8. Perform maintenance work in accordance with these instructions. Be sure to **always turn off the power** before servicing the machine.
